### Youth T-Ball, Baseball, and Softball

Children must be between the ages of 5 and 15 as of May 1. The registration fee is \$45 for Kannapolis residents and \$65 for non-residents, which includes the cost of uniforms, practices and games.



Scholarships and sponsorships are available. Gloves are mandatory and must be provided by the participant. Cleats are encouraged, but not required. Metal cleats are not allowed.

Practices will begin the week of March 17, and games will begin April 5.

#### **Youth Soccer**

Children must be between the ages of 3 and 15 as of February 1. The registration fee is \$45 for Kannapolis residents and \$65 for non-residents, which includes

the cost of uniforms, practices and games. Scholarships and sponsorships are available. Shin guards are mandatory and must be provided by the participant. Cleats are encouraged, but not required. Metal cleats are not allowed.

Practices will begin the week of March 17, and games will begin April 5.


