- 24' x 25' holds approximately 36 people (Shelter E holds approximately 24 people)

- Half Day: \$25 (9:00 am 2:30 pm / 3:00 pm 8:30 pm)

Shelter B:

- 24' x 65' holds approximately 96 people
- Full Day: \$80 (9:00 am 8:30 pm)
- Half Day: \$45 (9:00 am 2:30 pm / 3:00 pm 8:30 pm)

Shelter D:

- 24' x 45' holds approximately 72 people
- Full Day: \$60 (9:00 am 8:30 pm)
- Half Day: \$35 (9:00 am 2:30 pm / 3:00 pm 8:30 pm)

The original CP Huntington was the first locomotive purchased by the Southern Pacific Railroad in 1864, during construction of the western portion of the First Transcontinental Railroad in North America.

WELCOME TO VILLAGE PARK!

You are welcome to bring a picnic, run along the greenway, walk your dog, and enjoy nature. The park has several attractions (train, carousel, splash pad, and amphitheater) with seasonal hours of operation, admission fees and specific regulations which are different from the general park. All attractions are handicap accessible.

GENERAL RULES

- Smoking (including vapes and e-cigarettes) is not permitted.
- No glass is permitted within the play areas.
- Pets are not allowed in the park during events, in the splash pad, train or carousel areas.
- All other park rules and policies apply.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

FOOD

Concessions are available for sale when attractions are open.

- No food or beverages are allowed on the train or carousel, or inside the fence at the splash pad.
- Outside food and beverages are allowed in the program room, amphitheater, and shelters.

HOURS

VILLAGE PARK: Open to the public seven days a week from dawn to dusk.

ATTRACTIONS: Hours vary by season, visit **www.kannapolisnc.gov** or call **704-920-4343** for exact times of operation.

- Summer: attractions are open seven days a week
- Spring and Fall: attractions are open on weekends only
- Christmas season: prices and hours of operation will vary



ADMISSION

VILLAGE PARK: FREE

ATTRACTIONS: Admission for all attractions: \$1.50 per person/per admittance/per attraction.

- Children 12 months and under: FREE
- Discounted rate: \$1.25 with the purchase of 10 or more tickets.

SPLASH PAD

- Parents accompanying children in the splash pad area, but not playing, will be admitted free of charge.
- Swimsuits are encouraged, but street clothes are acceptable. Cut-off shorts are not permitted. Shoes can also be worn and water/swim shoes are encouraged.
- Children not potty trained must wear swim diapers while playing in the splash pad. For your convenience, these are available for purchase at the concession/admission window.
- Outside food and beverages are not allowed inside the fence.
- The splash pad operates with a state of the art re-circulating system in order to conserve water.
