SECTION C BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION

A signed Authorization for Release of Personal Information for Employment/Volunteer Purposes is required.

Coach's Code of Conduct

1. I will do my best to insure that all participants have fun playing sports.
2. I will place the emotional and physical well being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win.
3. I will be knowledgeable in the rules of each sport that I coach.
4. I will, to the best of my ability, teach all participants the the rules and skills of the game, the values of teamwork, and the meaning of good sportsmanship.
5. I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for my players.
6. I will lead by example and demonstrate "good" sportsmanship before, during, and after the game.
7. I will assure that "all participants get the opportunity to play."
8. I will communicate with the parents of the participants on my team and inform them of all team rules, practices, and games.
9. I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for children and not adults.
10. I will report to City of Kannapolis Parks and Recreation staff any type of misconduct by observed coaches, players, parents or officials, so that it may be dealt with appropriately.
