



City of Kannapolis Adopt-A-Street (AAS) Program POLICY

Adopting Organization's Commitment

- The adopting organization must sign a 2-year Commitment Agreement (*pages 2-5*) to clean the adopted section of a City of Kannapolis maintained roadway. The commitment may be canceled upon written notice from the adopting organization to Margaret Young, AAS Coordinator, at myoung@kannapolisnc.gov.
- Minimum of 1 mile (approximately 14 city blocks) of street is to be cleaned. This may be a single street or an area (subdivision or section of town).
- The adopted section of roadway must be cleaned at least 4 times per year, with one being for Earth Day in April.
- The minimum age of participants is 12 years old and every participant below the age of 18 is required to sign a parental release form (*page 6*).
- The minimum number of adult (over 21) participants is 1.
- 1 additional adult participant is required for each 6 volunteers under the age of 18.
- The adult assigned to oversee minor participants should be within a reasonable distance of the participants at all times during the clean up process.

City of Kannapolis Will Provide

- Garbage bags, gloves, safety vests, and pick-up tools. There will be a checklist (*page 7*) of supplies provided to the adopting organization, which are to be returned within 5 business days after the event to Public Works. Cleanup Event Permits need to be submitted at least 5 business days prior to the scheduled event.
- Street signs designating adopting organization's name and the year their commitment began.
- A certificate of completion, suitable for framing, and other recognition for each participating group.
- Traffic control devices as necessary.
- Pick up and disposal of filled bags.

Requirements of the Adopting Organization

- The adopting organization will designate 1 person and 1 alternate per group to be the liaison with the AAS Coordinator.
- Each adopting organization coordinator will be required to attend a safety training session and will be responsible for training the volunteers within their organization.
- All participants must sign/be registered on the Adopting Organization's 2-year Commitment Agreement before being permitted to participate in the clean up. The Commitment Agreement also serves as a waiver/release for each participant.
- The adopting organization's liaison will contact the AAS Coordinator and provide the attached registration form (*page 8*) a minimum of 5 working days prior to all cleanup activities.

Recycling

- The City of Kannapolis encourages recycling of collected debris. The adopting organization will be responsible for taking all recyclables to a recycling center and all proceeds will be the property of the adopting organization.
- Any bags of recyclables that are left with the garbage will be collected by the City and will be disposed of as garbage.



City of Kannapolis Adopt-a-Street (AAS) Program 2-YEAR COMMITMENT FORM

The City of Kannapolis ("City") and _____ (name of business, organization, or individual) recognize the needs and desirability of litter-free and visually improved streets.

The Adopt-A-Street program has been established for community civic organizations, churches, schools and individuals as well as business and industry to contribute towards the effort of maintaining a cleaner and more beautiful street-side.

As indicated by their signatures on the back of this agreement, the individual participants of the named entity are aware of the nature of the work, which is to be performed and have agreed to follow the City's rules, policies, safety guidelines, and instructions. If the above-named entity or individual enters into a contract with a business, organization, or individual to clean the entity's adopted section of street ("a contracted service"), the contract service agrees that it is aware of the nature of the work, which is to be performed, and has agreed to follow City's rules, policies, safety guidelines, and instructions. The entity contact person, on behalf of the entity, and each individual participate must execute and return to the AAS Coordinator a signed Hold Harmless and Release Form (copy attached). The individual participants agree that signs bearing the group's name shall be installed solely at the discretion of the City.

If the above named entity or individual enters into a contract with a business, organization, or individual to clean its adopted section of highway, it agrees to notify the City of Kannapolis Adopt-A-Street Coordinator in writing within ten calendar days of the agreement and acknowledges that failure to notify the AAS Coordinator of such action may result in termination of the agreement.

The above-name entity or individual volunteers to pick up litter four times a year (more if necessary), with one being for Earth Day in April, to promote a better environment in the community.
