## Policy on 25 MPH Speed Limits in Residential Areas

City residents may request a 25 MPH speed limit on residential streets. The procedure for obtaining a lowered speed limit involves a two-step process:

## <u>STEP 1:</u>

- 1. Complete and submit a Neighborhood Speed Limit Request Form. This information is needed by the Public Works Department to make a preliminary determination that the street qualifies for a lowered speed limit. The evaluation will determine if the street(s) requested are eligible based on the following criteria:
  - Street cannot be a thoroughfare
  - Street cannot be part of the State highway system
  - Street must have less than 2,500 vehicles per day
  - Street must not be designed to be reasonably traveled at 35 MPH

## <u>STEP 2:</u>

- Within 30 days, if your street is eligible for a 25 MPH speed limit, you will be sent petition forms. <u>You must obtain the signatures of at least 75% of the residents or property owners of</u> <u>each parcel on the street(s)</u>. Only one signature per address or parcel will be counted towards <u>the 75%</u>.
- 2. Mail or deliver the completed petition to:

- 3. After validation, the petition will be forwarded to City Council for approval.
- 4. Upon approval by City Council, appropriate 25 MPH speed limit signs will be erected by the City in accordance with the U.S. Department of Transportation Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
